

Boys Golf: Jensen Beach wins Sailfish Invitational

STUART — Matt Glass shot a 1-over-par 73 for medalist honors as Jensen Beach's boys golf team won the inaugural Sailfish Invitational at Sailfish Point.

Liam Snyder added a 79, Oliver Tranter had an 81 and Brent Graham an 82 for Jensen Beach, which had 315 to earn the Armstrong Cup.

Pine School finished six strokes back at 321. "It was within (six) strokes, so it could have gone either way," Jensen Beach coach Larry Sweazy said. "Not our best score, but's a win and we'll learn from it."

Martin County (351), South Fork (377) and Community Christian (410) rounded out the team scoring.

Grant Mortell had a 78 and Nick Gagliardi shot 79 for Pine School. Martin County's Dominick Vennari was the only other player to break 80.

The Armstrong Cup is named for David M. Armstrong, a former Sailfish Point club champion and president.
