A Proclamation

Commending the Sailfish Point Property Owner's and
Country Club Association in Martin County, Florida

- Whereas, the Sailfish Point Property Owner's Association and Martin County share a submerged land lease for the navigation channel serving Sailfish Point Marina and adjacent recreational areas; and
- Whereas, Sailfish Point Property Owner's Association has been maintaining the navigation channel by placing the sand on the beaches adjacent to Sailfish Point; and
- Whereas, fall and winter storms caused significant beach erosion to Bathtub Beach resulting in beach closures; and
- Whereas, the Sailfish Point Property Owner's Association gave Martin County 4,862 cubic yards of beach sand valued at \$90,000 for Bathtub Beach; and
- Whereas, in addition to providing beach sand, the Association provided significant resources with engineering and project management oversight that was necessary to obtain regulatory approvals from state and federal agencies to place the material on Bathtub Beach prior to the beginning of sea turtle nesting season.

Now, therefore, be it Proclaimed by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that the members of the Sailfish Point Property Owner's and Country Club Association are hereby commended for their efforts to rebuild Bathtub Beach during the period of December 2010 through April 2011.
