



2020-2021 FISHING MEMO

Season Long Fishing Tournament

DATES

Competition begins on **November 2**, and continues through **April 23**. Awards will be given out at the SPYC Dinner that evening.

OFFSHORE

Compete for two prestigious Sailfish release trophies – **ANGLER OF THE YEAR** and **TOP AMATEUR BOAT** – each awarded for the most billfish released. (Note that the sailfish competition end date has been extended to coincide with that of the other species) Awards will also be given for the heaviest **Cobia, Blackfin Tuna, Mahi, Kingfish, Swordfish and Wahoo**.

INSHORE

Compete for the **TOP INSHORE ANGLER** trophy. Anglers can enter one fish – their longest – of each of five species: **Snook, Jack, Redfish, Seatrout and Pompano**. Snook account for approximately half of the total points, earning between one and five points, with five awarded for the longest. Each of the other four species – Jack, Redfish, Seatrout and Pompano – will be worth between one and three points. The trophy will be awarded to the angler accumulating the most points.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Anglers may fish from shore or aboard any boat (including charters) but all billfish and the five inshore species must be caught in our local waters. Please submit a photo of each inshore species to Lisa via email clearly showing its length. The six other offshore species may also be caught in the Bahamas but must be weighed at the SFP Marina.

Boats that fish professionally with a full-time crew are **not** eligible to win the **Top Amateur Boat** award.

When fishing offshore, bait must be rigged using non-offset circle hooks.

Once an angler wins **Angler of the Year** twice, their name will be inscribed on the **Master Angler Trophy**. They will be ineligible to win the award again.

The combined entry fee for offshore and inshore competitions is \$100. This fee also covers non-registered anglers fishing aboard a registered boat. Individuals may register and fish from land or aboard any boat(s) including charters.

Last year's entrants will automatically be entered again unless they specifically request otherwise. New participants may register at any time. Contact Lisa at the Marina 772-225-1700 or at l.dyer@sailfishpoint.com.
